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**Abstract**

**Summary of Search:**

The subject of Iran's nuclear program of subjects that are of great importance in the field of international studies in general and strategic studies, in particular, since it is not about the future of the Islamic Republic of Iran, but the future of the Middle East, particularly the Persian Gulf, as well as being closely related to the future proliferation of nuclear weapons between the Gulf countries in the region.

As the focus of research about the importance of research in the Iranian nuclear program in light of the critical importance of the Iranian nuclear program and its implications on the possible future of international security and regional levels, particularly the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC).

Stems the importance of research in the Iranian nuclear program through what have been raised and still raised by this program from the contradictions and differences of views between Iran and insists on being dedicated to peaceful purposes, or from the other side Representative in the United States of America, which cast doubt on the orientations of the Iranian nuclear program, which it sees It contains within it the secret military nuclear program is aimed at the final outcome to the possession of nuclear weapons

Consistent with this, the problem of research focused on the impact of Iran's nuclear program to balance regional and international levels in the Middle East in general and the Persian Gulf in particular, in the case of a designed to get Iran to the nuclear power (nuclear weapons, actual) under the environments of regional and international variables of the current after the end of the Cold War, especially after the events of September 11, 2001.

Starting from this problem, the hypothesis that will be launched, including search is that the regional balance and strategic in the Persian Gulf is influenced to a large degree the nature of Iran's nuclear program, and that the United States seeks to impose the agenda of dominating the U.S. strategy on Iran as part of its international strategy in general and in the Gulf region Arab in particular, which requires the order of the priorities of the strategic balance in accordance with the interests and objectives and agendas of Israel by trying to convince the international community that the real goal that Iran is seeking to achieve from behind its nuclear program is nuclear weapons.

Hence, we conclude that the volume of threats and risks posed by Iran's nuclear program will increase in the foreseeable future, especially if Iran has nuclear weapons and then practice a new type of behavior strategy based on the policies of deterrence new by owning the actual power (nuclear capabilities, real), , forcing other countries to enter into the framework of a nuclear arms race, which will have a significant negative impact on the future of nuclear balance in the regional environment is stable, for example, the Persian Gulf.

Thus, the American military presence in Iraq and Afghanistan and Maravgah of the repercussions of the emergence of the Iranian nuclear program has led to disruptions affected statements that try to the security of the Gulf region and its stability, particularly after disruption of regional balance in the interest of Iran, and these implications have stimulated the Gulf states turn to seek a balance in the relations with the rest of the regional and international parties to confront the Iranian nuclear project

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
